### **Requirements that must be submitted for consideration**

- Completed Application
- Official Transcripts
- Minimum 2.5 GPA required
- Type & attach a 2 page description of your background in agriculture that includes the following:
  - 4-H and FFA activities you have participated in
  - Offices held (if any)
  - Competitive teams i.e. dairy judging team, job interview team, etc.
  - Any other activities you feel are important to mention
  - After describing your background, please describe what your future goals are in the agriculture industry, i.e. your career choice, where you want to work and why.
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher or school staff dated within the last 3 months. (This does not need to come from a FFA Advisor. It may come from any teacher/staff on campus that can best describe why you are deserving of this scholarship.)
- A FFA Advisor or County 4-H Office review and signature
